

Rotary Short Term Camps and Tours – Summer 2017

Rotary Districts in many countries sponsor summer camps and tours to foster peace and understanding and give young people the opportunity to experience another culture in the company of other young people from around the world. These camps/tours each have their own theme and character, age restrictions and costs. Camp organizers typically only accept one applicant from each country so that it is truly an international experience designed to build relationships.

To apply – a STEP application must be completed and an accompanying participant letter should reflect why the student believes that they would be an excellent ambassador and candidate for the camp. Applicants are interviewed and must be accepted as part of the North Star Youth Exchange STEP program before they can apply for camp acceptance. A program fee of \$250 is payable to North Star if student is accepted for a camp/tour. Participants must pay the camp fee, purchase their own flight/transportation to the camp and bring spending money. Applications received earlier have best chance of acceptance.
